Missing Harrison Township Boater

Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham reports that at approximately 4:20pm yesterday afternoon, the Macomb County Dispatch Center received a report from a resident in Harrison Township stating that she heard calls of distress from a boater on Lake St. Clair.

Macomb County Sheriff Marine Division deputies and the United States Coast Guard were dispatched to an area between MacRay Harbor and the mouth of the Clinton River. They located an overturned 12-foot aluminum fishing boat. They also found a dead Boston Terrier floating nearby. The boat registration came back to a 47 year old Harrison Township man.

Sheriff Deputies interviewed the boat-owner's girlfriend, and learned that he had taken his dog and gone fishing earlier Monday.

An exhaustive area search was conducted by Sheriff Patrol boats, and resources from the United States Coast Guard, however the man could not be located.

The search was concluded at approximately 1am on Tuesday morning.

As of 8am (11-04), members of the Sheriff's Marine Division and the Sheriff's Dive Team have resumed their search.
