### MEDIA CRIME REPORT

A 45 year old Harrison Township man was arrested early Saturday morning (4-18-15) after a felonious assault at a Mt. Clemens bar.

At approximately 1:30am, Macomb Sheriff deputies were dispatched to Madison's Pub (at 15 N. Walnut) after a patron described an altercation with another man in the bar.

According to the complainant, a 22 year old Mount Clemens man, he was in the bar and there was a verbal exchange between he and the assailant. The assailant walked past him, pulled a handgun from his waistband, pushed the barrel into his stomach and called him a derogatory term.

The younger man retreated and reported the incident to the bar security staff. Bar personnel called the Sheriffs Office and then watched the man as he left the bar and walked to a black Ford Edge that was parked in the Roskopp parking lot behind the bar. The man then tried to return to the bar but was denied admittance.

Deputies arrived and investigated the matter. A loaded black, 38 caliber "Rohm" revolver was recovered from his Ford Edge. He was arrested and brought to the Macomb County Jail.

**Ramiz Gigic** was charged with:

- Count 1: Assault w/a Dangerous Weapon – Felonious Assault (4 year felony)
- Count 2: Carrying a Concealed Weapon (5 year felony)
