Suspicious Situation in Macomb Township

On Sunday afternoon (6-7-15), a Macomb County sheriff deputy assigned to the Macomb Township Substation was dispatched to an address in the 55000 block of Frost Drive for a suspicious situation complaint.

The complainant was the mother of an 11 year-old girl who related that her daughter (and her 11 year old girlfriend) were playing outside their residence when an older man (driving a small blue vehicle) approached them.

According to the girls, the man asked them if they wanted \$10 and a kitten. The girls told the deputy that the man pulled a kitten out of a cooler. The girls told the deputy that they told the man "no" and ran to their home where the mother of one of the girls called 911. The girls told the deputy that the vehicle drove down the street, turned around, drove past again and then left the area.

The girls described the man as an "older white male, with gray hair, and missing his teeth".

They could not provide a clothing description.

The car was only described as "a smaller, blue, older-model vehicle".

Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description.
