Harrison Township Drunk-Driving Crash and Arrest

Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham reports that, on the 4th of July, a Macomb Sheriff Deputy on patrol in Harrison Township observed a Chrysler 200 drive thru the front of a business in Harrison Township.

At approximately 2am, the deputy was driving northbound on Jefferson (near Emerick) behind a 2015 Chrysler 200 when he observed the vehicle drive thru a stop sign (at South River Rd) and drive straight into the front of the Blue Water Marine business which is located at 30201 South River Road.

The deputy reported the crash to the Sheriff's Dispatch Center as the driver of the vehicle crawled from the wreckage. The business was extensively damaged.

The driver of the vehicle, a 28 year-old Novi man admitted to the deputies that he had been drinking at a local bar prior to the crash. He was not injured in the incident.

He was subsequently arrested and transported to the Macomb County Jail. Once there, he was given a breathalyzer test with results of .16 and .17% BAC.

The man was charged with OWI, 1st Offense.

The man posted a \$100 bond and was released from Jail later the same day.
