Mt. Clemens Home Invasion Investigation

On Saturday (7-25) at 6:12pm, the Macomb County Sheriff's Office Emergency Dispatch Center received a 911 call from a resident of a home on Canfield Street in the City of Mt. Clemens. According to the caller, four subjects wearing masks entered her home and announced a robbery. The assailants, two armed with knives and two armed with handguns, put a knife to the throat of the 38 year old woman and demanded money.

She stated that she was forced to the upstairs of the home where she was told to show the assailants where the money was or she would be shot. She stated she gave them money from her wallet and she was pushed face-down onto a bed.

Aside from the complainant, there were five other persons in the house at the time of the incident. They were also accosted by the intruders and forced to the floor at gunpoint. The suspects took computers, cellphones, iPods, two (2) Sony PlayStations and cash from the home and from the occupants.

After taking the items, the suspects fled the home.

Macomb County Sheriff deputies were converging on the residence when one of the deputies located a gray Pontiac Grand Prix travelling on southbound Gratiot from Canfield. The vehicle was occupied by five subjects who matched the description of the suspects from the robbery. The deputy followed the vehicle as it turned onto Joy Blvd.

A traffic stop was initiated on Joy Blvd and Colchester.

Deputies were able to see items (in the car) that matched the description of things that were reportedly taken in the robbery.

All of the subjects in the car were taken into custody without incident.

Arrested were:

Channor Dior Lewis (18 years old) from Clinton Township
Dwayne Cooper Rasberry Jr. (17) from Clinton Township
Joshua Lee Mills (18) from Clinton Township
Jesse Alex-Ondre Stevens (19) from Mount Clemens

The individuals were charged with the following crimes:

*Chevas Walker

Count #1: Robbery - Armed (Life Felony)
Count #2: Home Invasion – 1st Degree (20-year felony)

Channor Lewis, Dwayne Rasberry, Joshua Mills and Jesse Stevens are all charged with:

Count #1: Robbery Armed
Count #2: Home Invasion – 1st Degree
Count #3: Unlawful Imprisonment (15-year felony)

*Suspect Chevas Walker has been identified as the driver of the vehicle during this incident, therefore he is not charged with the “Unlawful Imprisonment”.

Deputies and detectives prepared a search warrant and subsequently recovered all of the stolen items from the gray, 2000 Pontiac Grand Prix. Deputies also recovered a loaded silver and black, 38 caliber Ruger revolver (handgun) and an airsoft gun. There was a folding knife and a box cutter in the vehicle as well. The Ruger handgun was subsequently determined to be stolen.

On Tuesday, 7-28-15, the five suspects were video-arraigned in the 41B District Court of Clinton Township.

Their bonds have been set at \$100,000 cash-or-surety and they are each expected back in Court on August 10, 2015.
