MT. CLEMENS, MI – October 15, 2015 - Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham relates that sheriff deputies and detectives are investigating a road rage incident which occurred Tuesday evening (10-13-15) in Harrison Township.

According to incident reports and witness statements, at approximately 5:45pm, a "911" caller reported that he was driving in the vicinity of Reimold & Crocker and he "exchanged words" with the female driver of a 2004 Lexus.

Both drivers advanced to a red light on Crocker at Metropolitan Parkway when the complainant, a 40 year-old man from Warren states that he stopped alongside the woman's SUV to confront her about her driving. The complainant states that he exited his 2003 Chevy pick-up truck, but remained on the driver's side. He told deputies that a verbal argument escalated and he reentered his vehicle. He said that he reached over, unrolled the passenger side window of his vehicle and he threw a soft-drink at the woman's car.

According to the man, the female driver produced a gun and fired a round at his truck. The man called "911".

Simultaneously, the Macomb County Emergency Dispatch Center received a "911" call from the female driver who told dispatchers that she had been in an altercation and that she had fired her handgun. She told dispatchers that she was now at a convenience store on Harper in Clinton Township.

Deputies arrived and interviewed her. She had a consistent version of events except she relates that the male driver of a red pick-up truck exited his vehicle at the red traffic signal, he walked around his own vehicle and approached hers. As he neared her car, he had a Styrofoam cup in his hand and he threw liquid in her

face. She states that she was “scared for her life” so she drew her handgun and fired a single shot.

Deputies located a Kel-Tec, 9mm Luger handgun in the “map pocket” on the drivers-side door of the woman’s gray Lexus RX330. The 36 year-old Harrison Township woman was arrested and transported to the Macomb County Jail.

According to the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN), the woman is a concealed pistol licensee (CPL).

Macomb Sheriff Evidence Technicians examined the Warren man’s pickup truck and there was a bullet hole through the passenger door and the window glass was shattered. They were able to retrieve the bullet from the arm-rest of his truck.

On Wednesday, 10-14-15, India Marchea McDougal was video-arraigned in the 41B District Court of Clinton Township.

She is charged with:

- Count 1: Assault w/Intent to Murder (Life felony)
- Count 2: Weapons – Felony Firearms (2 year felony)
- Count 3: Controlled Substance – Poss. Less than 25 Grams (4 year felony)

She was given a \$750,000 cash-or-surety bond. She is due back in court on 10-26-15 @ 8:30am.

The male subject also faces several (misdemeanor) charges.
