Macomb Township

On Tuesday evening (10-13-15) at approximately 6:20pm, Macomb County Sheriff Deputies assigned to the Macomb Township Substation were summoned to Atwood Elementary School located at 45690 North Ave in Macomb Township.

Visitors to the school called to report that they had observed a man walking through the school parking lot and he was exposing his bare backside. According to the witnesses, the individual did so "multiple times". The witnesses, parents who were dropping off students for a school-sanctioned meeting notified the school principal two hours after the incident.

Deputies responded and checked the school and the nearby vicinity but they were unable to locate the man.

On 10-14-15, Sheriff deputies returned to the school and met with the principal and learned additional details:

Witnesses stated that the man was on the edge of the school parking lot (near North Ave) and he was walking north. He stopped three times, and dropped his pants exposing his bare backside. The man then continued walking north on North Avenue and then east on Harrellson Dr.

The man was described as a white male, approximately 5'10" with a medium build. He was approximately 45 years of age. He was described as mostly bald but with gray hair at the sides of his head. He was wearing a black leather jacket and khaki pants.
