MT. CLEMENS, MI – April 21, 2015 - On Tuesday April 14 at approximately 11:45am, the Macomb County Sheriff Office was called on to assist the Michigan Department of Corrections in searching the apartment of a parolee in Sterling Heights. The MDOC had received information that their parolee, Eric Lamar Smith, 34 had resumed trafficking in narcotics.

Smith was detained by a Michigan Department of Corrections Parole Agent while a K-9 Deputy with the Sheriff's Office assisted with a search of the man's apartment located on Independence Drive.

The officers searched the residence and located 28 zip-lock baggies which each contained a white powdery substance subsequently determined to be cocaine.

Furthermore, they located 22 "bindles" of a yellowish powder which was field tested and determined to be heroin.

Smith was arrested on the new charges and he was turned over to the custody of the Michigan Department of Corrections.

The Macomb County Prosecuting Attorneys Office has issued a warrant for Smith for two counts of Controlled Substance – Delivery/Manufacture Less than 50 grams (Cocaine, Heroin or Another Narcotic).

This charge carries a potential 20-year prison term.

He remains in the custody of the Michigan Dept of Corrections and will be arraigned at a later date.
