#### **Macomb Township Fatal Car Crash**

Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham reports that his agency investigated a single-car fatal traffic-crash that occurred at approximately 12:30pm on Friday afternoon (May 22<sup>nd</sup>). A black 2005 Cadillac CTS driven by Umberto George Orlando was travelling east bound on 26 Mile Rd. immediately before the crash.

According to eyewitness accounts, his vehicle ran off the roadway on the south side of 26 Mile Rd, near Indian Trail. The vehicle struck several trees and bushes before coming to rest in a ditch. The vehicle had heavy front-end damage.

The driver was alone in the vehicle at the time of the crash, and he was transported to McLaren Hospital (in Mt. Clemens) where he was pronounced dead.

Mr. Orlando was 84 years old and lived in Chesterfield Township.

#### **Suspicious Situation in New Haven**

The Macomb County Sheriff's Office is investigating a report of some shots fired into a residence in the Village of New Haven. According to an eyewitness, he was standing in front of a residence when he observed a dark-colored vehicle, possibly a black Ford Focus drive down the 59000 block of W. Brockton. The vehicle made a u-turn, came back down the same street and the witness stated

that he heard three gunshots. According to the witness, the car had tinted windows, but he thought that there was only one person inside the vehicle.

Deputies searched the area but were unable to find any shell casings. However they did observe two bullet holes in the garage door of a residence. The incident occurred on Saturday, 5-23-15 at approximately 10pm. No one was struck by the bullets.

Deputies spoke to the lone occupant of the home who stated that he was house-sitting for the owners who were "up-north".
