2015 U.S. Police Canine Association Certifications to be held in Macomb County

The Macomb County Sheriff's Office announces that the United States Police Canine Association (Region 19) will hold its 2015 certifications here in Macomb County this weekend. The Certifications will be held August 7th, 8th and 9th 2015 at various locations in the County.

The Certifications will showcase police dogs from seven departments: Chatham-Kent Police Service, Guelph Police Service, Windsor Police Service, Sterling Heights Police Department, Dearborn Heights and the Macomb County Sheriff's Office.

There will be 15 dogs who will undergo testing for certifications in criminal apprehension/bite work and obedience, evidence search and agility.

Two of the segments will be held at the Powell Elementary School, 62100 Jewell Rd, in Washington Township. These are the Certifications that are open to the public. The "Obedience" segment will be held on Friday, August 7th @ 9:30am. The Apprehension/Bite Work segment will be held on Sunday, August 9th @ 9:00am.
